(A)

(B)

Every year many people get hurt or lose their lives in traffic accidents. How can we keep safe when we are walking near the roads? First, we must obey the traffic rules. We must cross the road only when we see the green “walk” sign. Second, before we cross the road, we must stop and look both ways—look left, look right and look left again. Third, we must never play on the street. Last, it's good to help children and old people cross the road. All of us should be very careful when we are walking near traffic.
